

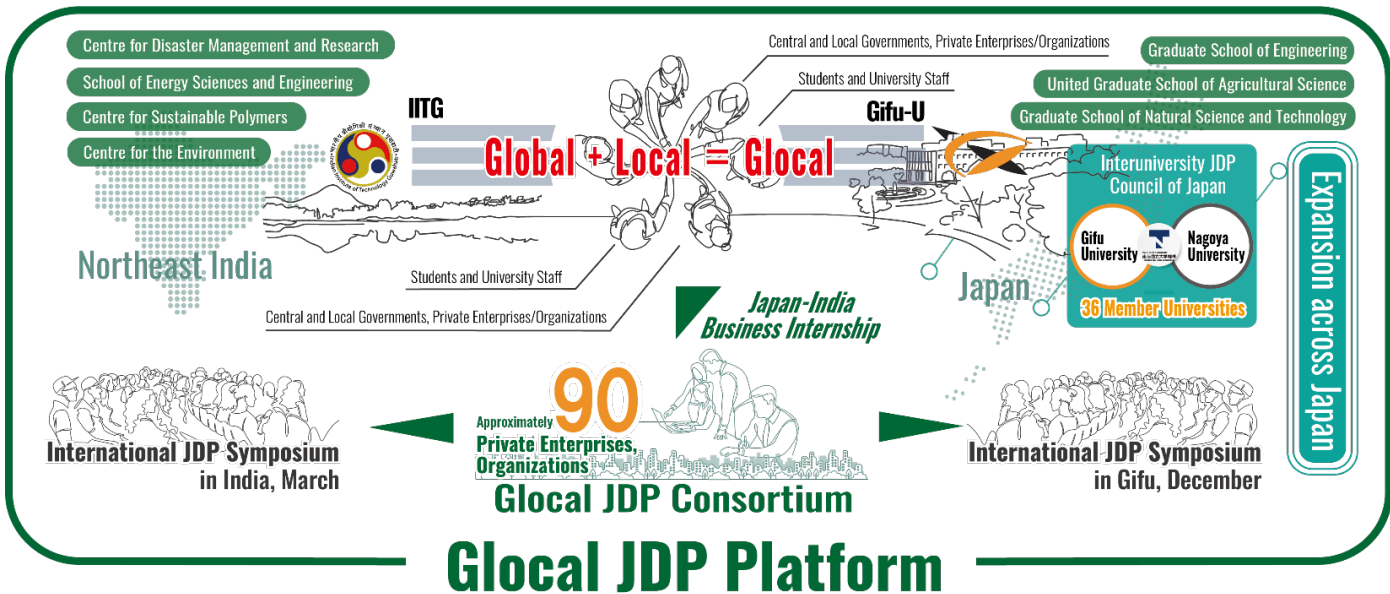

Co-Create “regional revitalization model” through JDP with Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati whose mission includes developing northeastern India

【Global Human Resource on the project】

PhD and master’s students of JDP are given an opportunity to interact with people from private sector in Japan and India through internship programs, international symposiums, etc. Being organizers of symposiums will also enable them to learn about global affairs, reinforce their leadership roles in collaboration between the two countries. They are expected to play a significant role at research/business organizations, think-tanks, consulting firms, etc. in Japan and India in the future. Undergraduate students who completed the programs can advance to a graduate school, engage in internationalization of public/private sector, work for tourism industry or international trade of local foods. We hope that program graduates can find employment at startup businesses with global initiatives or create their own businesses as glocal entrepreneurs.

【Feature on the project】

- Cultivate highly skilled glocal talents who can spearhead regional development
- Launch “certificate endorsing” programs for wider application to India, etc.
- Facilitate Exchange between Japan and India by creating “Glocal JDP Platform”
