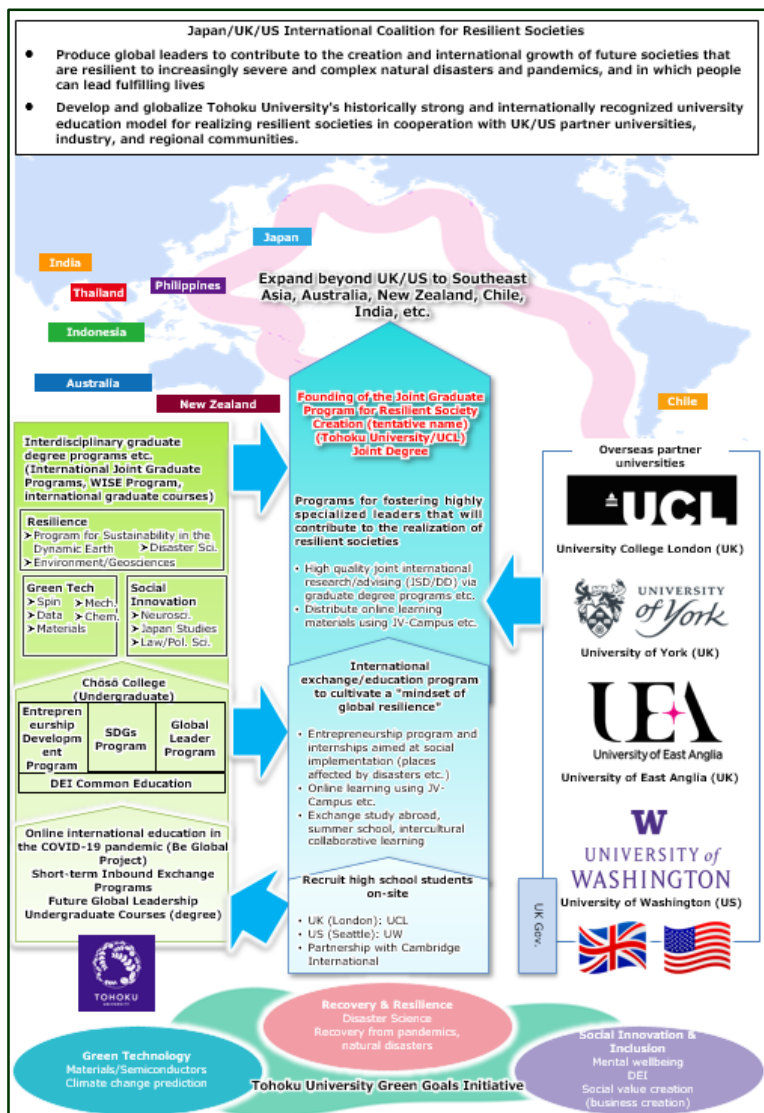

International Collaboration between Japanese, British, and American Universities to Create Resilient Societies

## 【Summary of Inter-University Exchange Projects】



## 【Summary of Exchange program】

This program is conducted by Tohoku University, which is a leader in sustainable society creation efforts, and like-minded counterpart universities abroad, to create a foundation of diversity, equity, and inclusion that will be the basis for realizing resilient societies while implementing international exchange and education for undergraduate students in Japan, the UK, and the US that fosters a mindset of "global resilience," in addition to cultivating leaders who will realize the creation and international growth of "global resilient societies" based on cutting-edge graduate-level educational research. It will contribute to the cultivation of leaders who will act as bridges between Japan and other countries by allowing students to learn together on-location in places affected by the Great East Japan Earthquake—a prominent site of resilient society implementation.

## 【Global Human Resource on the project】

The program will foster global leaders who will contribute to the solving of environmental/social issues such as climate change, and the creation and international growth of future societies that are resilient to natural disasters and pandemics, and in which people can lead fulfilling lives. Specifically, it will 1) broadly foster leaders who are conscious of diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI); understand green technologies, SDGs, and disaster prevention/mitigation from an international perspective; and have a "global resilience mindset." At the graduate level, in addition to the above, it will 2) foster highly specialized leaders who will contribute to implementing resilient societies through cutting-edge joint research/advising in collaboration with prominent overseas universities.

## 【Features of the project】

In 2021, as the culmination of its 10 years of effort since the Great East Japan Earthquake, Tohoku University moved forward with its university-wide "Green Goals Initiative," which is composed of three pillars: ① restoration & resilience, ② green technology, and ③ social innovation & inclusion.

We will implement an international exchange/education program that cultivates multi-tiered global resilience, and we additionally aim to create a joint diploma program together with partner universities in UK and the US with which we have built strategic relationships (University College London, University of York, University of East Anglia, University of Washington) under a university-wide system of accountability and cooperation based on this project's mid/long-term vision.
